What's New on QCOR?

New Features

An additional survey type has been added to OCOR for the survey and deficiency reports. These surveys are referred to as Infection Control for nursing homes and Special for other provider types. These types of inspections look at specific healthcare areas related to infection control.

A downloadable Code of Federal Regulations deficiency tags guide is available in the Resources tab.

Also, users can now view information related to transplant programs under the Hospitals link on QCOR. There is additional information on transplant programs in the QCOR FAQs.

Home Health Agencies (HHA), Ambulatory Surgical Centers (ASC), and Hospices Information

Due to system migrations, HHA provider and survey information is only complete and accurate through May 19, 2021, ASC provider and survey information will only be complete and accurate through May 9, 2022. Hospice provider and survey information will only be accurate and complete through September 29, 2022. Information about specific enforcement actions related to HHAs, ASCs, and hospices remain available by request, under the Freedom of Information Act. CMS is working to update the QCOR website during the system migration.
